ENGLAND STAR ADMITS ASSAULT

Boys beat girls and number of A* grades falls after A-level shake-up

THE number of A* grades at A-level dropped this year after the biggest exam shake-up of a generation.

Results published today revealed that the proportion of A*s fell by 0.3 percentage points to eight per cent, the lowest since 2013.

This year thousands of teenagers sat new "toughened up" exams with no coursework or modules.

It came as students from the school in the shadow of Grenfell Tower said they were proud to be

bringing a sense of hope back to the community. Pupils returned to Kensington Aldridge Academy to collect their A-level results and said they were "realising our potential for those who didn't get that chance".

Results published by exam boards today reveal:

- Boys outdid girls in top grades, with 26.6 per cent of boys' entries graded A* or A, compared with 26.2 per cent of girls' — only the second year boys have surpassed girls.
