West Florida Argos came into this game ranked 17th with a win they go on to (21-4, 16-3 GSC) winning 12 straight, while Valdosta State Blazers fall to (17-9, 11-7 GSC). The Argos goes out in fashion to win by 30, 69-39 the fewest points scored by an opponent all season.
